Gently Used Clothing & Shoes

We accept all sizes of men's and women's clothing including shirts, pants, jackets, coats, shoes, socks, belts and other clothing items. We ask that clothing be clean and free of excessive stains, damage, or odors.

Blankets & Sleeping Bags

Many of our guests reside in local shelters and may lack adequate bedding. We accept and distribute new & used blankets, comforters, and sleeping bags.

Travel-Sized Toiletries

We are <u>constantly</u> in need of travel-size or individually packaged hygiene items including soap, deodorant, toothbrushes, toothpaste, shampoo, feminine hygiene, etc.

55 Gallon Trash Bags / Drum Liners

We use 55-gallon drums to sort clothing donations. We go through hundreds of drum liners each month! We specifically need 55-gallon size. We cannot use the smaller kitchen-size bags.

Individually-Wrapped Snacks & Desserts

Bags of chips, packs of crackers, granola bars, cakes, cookies, etc

Disposable To-Go Containers

We serve thousands of meals a year, in disposable to-go trays. We prefer the 3-compartment variety. These can be foam or paper/cardboard. We recommend donors purchase these at our local favorite Paper Supply, but they can be found at most retail stores or online.

Household Goods / Appliances / Furniture
